The thorough digitization and networking of processes has reached the midmarket. Companies are focusing on replacing fragmented processes with integrated ones to remain competitive internationally in terms of speed, quality and price. Previous system islands, for example, in procurement, production, warehousing or logistics, are being systematically linked to the lead ERP system. At the same time, communication with third-party solutions on the customer and vendor side has intensified. The goal is a high degree of process continuity and automation across company boundaries.

One challenge midmarket businesses face in this context is the IT expertise required to implement a variety of connections. This can often only be achieved through intense involvement of specialized IT service providers: Both the implementation of an interface and its subsequent modification and maintenance require a certain amount of specialist expertise, which is difficult to build and maintain within the company.

Although companies benefit from significant improvements in the quality, stability and customer-orientation of their processes, the cost of maintaining a custom, end-to-end process landscape remains relatively high.

REDUCE THE OPERATING COSTS OF SYSTEM CONNECTIONS

With abas Connect, abas offers an integration platform for midmarket businesses that enables highly flexible, standardized communication between systems, such as machine control systems, assistance systems, warehouse management software, self-propelled systems, web services, etc. and abas ERP as the central ERP solution.

The integration platform converts the messages and handles routing between the systems in the background so that the setup and maintenance of routes is based solely on configurations using a graphical interface – no programming necessary.


EASILY INTEGRATE DIVERSE TECHNOLOGIES

abas Connect is an applicationneutral, message-based integration platform that enables applications to communicate with each other regardless of their native data structure. For this, abas Connect uses defined, universal start and end points so that no interfaces need to be adapted. Each system provider remains in their own language and does not need to have or acquire any knowledge of abas ERP or thirdparty systems.

abas Connect converts the messages and handles the routing between the start and end points. It uses a variety of enterprise-integration-pattern-based building blocks to establish routes.

INTEGRATION IN ABAS ERP

abas Connect also handles the data exchange with abas ERP*. With abas Connect, systems equipped with very different interfaces can be connected easily to abas ERP. Neither the interface of the system to be integrated nor the processing logic needs to be modified or programmed. Instead, the connection is made via the abas Connect route editor, a graphical interface to configure and maintain routes between systems.

CENTRAL INTERFACE HANDLING

abas Connect doesn't focus solely on a simplified, standardized connection to abas ERP. The goal of the integration platform is to standardize the setup and maintenance of all your IT ecosystem interfaces. abas Connect can translate messages into any format, enabling third-party systems to communicate with each other. You can use communication building blocks to map, for example, validation or synchronization processes.

Furthermore, unlike with individual interface connections, it's also possible to address several systems simultaneously with a single request when using abas Connect. You profit from streamlined data exchange as well as significantly simplified adaptation.

ONE PLATFORM – A MULTI-TUDE OF CONNECTIONS

abas Connect impresses with its high degree of flexibility and custom adaptability. Essentially any type of interface can be connected. The integration platform provides a set of interfaces (e.g. REST, SQL) for receiving and sending messages in various data formats (e.g. JSON, XML, CSV or ASCII), so that classic machine and interface connections as well as the integration of Mobile Apps or web services can be realized with little modification effort.

SIMPLE, COST-EFFECTIVE MAINTENANCE

The user-friendly route editor also considerably simplifies interface maintenance. Standard adjustments and extensions to routes can be performed within the company. To avoid binding administration to a single person, a detailed description of each route is provided so that the information required for an adaptation can be found quickly. Even larger modifications to interfaces can be implemented with significantly less effort using routing start and end points. If starting point A changes, then only this point has to be adjusted in the route editor. The endpoints to the other systems receiving messages from A via abas Connect remain unchanged.

QUICK IMPLEMENTATION

Thanks to simple configuration via the route editor, applications can be quickly linked to abas ERP and with each other, without any programming. The route editor is easy to operate and requires minimal training. The installation on your abas ERP server or another server only takes a few minutes. All this helps to ensure that integrating applications with abas Connect can be accomplished in very short time.


